

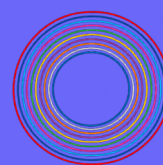

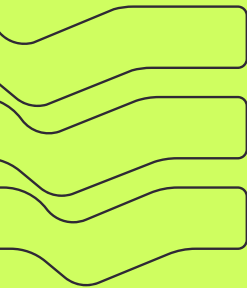

Package Price

Running in Rome means running through 2,000 years of history. The course passes the Colosseum, Piazza Venezia, Piazza Navona, St. Peter’s Basilica, the Circus Maximus, and the Lungotevere along the banks of the Tiber River. Few marathons in the world combine sport and history within the same kilometer.

The race starts at around 8:30 a.m. on Sunday. March in Rome marks the transition from winter to spring, with highs between 14°C and 17°C, lows around 7°C, and about a 25% chance of rain on a typical day. The days become progressively sunnier, and the temperature is comfortable for racing.

For the 32nd edition, we take care of the logistics. You focus on crossing the finish line.

Registration is available exclusively as part of our travel packages and cannot be purchased separately.
